Counselling Process Year 10 & 11 2022

Step I - Subject Information Night Wednesday 4 August

Students with their parents use this information to discuss subject preferences in preparation for their course counselling appointment (Year 9s & 10s given a selection proforma in classes in New Horizons, LIA and HG classes – see Skoolbag)

Step 2 - Course Counselling

Year 9 into 10 students 2021

Friday 6 August from 8:45am to 3:00pm – one-on-one with counsellor / student

Parent follow up with signing selections - Students hand in no later than Wednesday I I August to Year 9 office

Year 10 into 11 students 2021

Thursday 12 August from 1:00pm to 8:00pm – MS Teams Links

Parents required (Book I appointment through Daymap – now open for booking)



Course counselling Year 10 & 11 2022

Step 3- Course confirmation

Prior to Course Confirmation, students will be provisionally allocated to subjects based on preferences. Appointments can be made with the Assistant Principal Tanya Au for changes to courses or during Course Confirmation evenings

Course Confirmation is a five-step re-enrolment process that requires students and families to:

- 1. Update all enrolment details completing information packs
- 2. Complete VASS enrolment (for VCE / VCAL/VET)
- 3. Complete Mullum Cluster VET studies
- 4. Ensure that all elective charges are paid for subjects that have been selected (Please be aware that enrolment in any study is not confirmed until full payment is received)
- Final confirmation of course

Course Confirmation is from 4:00pm to 8:00pm on Wednesday 8 September or Monday 13 September

Enhancement Program 2022

- You can apply to study a VCE or VET Subject in 2022
- Enhancement studies can be beneficial for some students who are recommended by their teachers.
- Depth and breadth to interests and talents
 - Enhancement studies should support your pathways plan
 - Challenge yourself
 - Places and subjects that are available may be limited
 - Year 9 assessment is looked at in the process
 - Student have been given applications with the possible subject choices on offer, which they will need teacher / Team Leader / parent endorsement

VET

- VET subjects are either scored like other VCE studies, or contribute a 10% block bonus to Aggregate score

VCE

- The VCE is usually a two year course administered by the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA).
- Over the two years, most full-time VCE students will undertake a total of 22 to 24 semester length units.
- At the end of the VCE students will obtain an ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admission Rank). The ATAR determines which institutions that student is eligible to attend.

VCAL - atEAST (School Based Apprenticeship or Traineeship)

A typical week will be as follows:

- 2 days at school to complete VCAL units
- I day TAFE (related to the work area) or on the job training
- 2 or 3 days paid work (minimum of 15 hours)


