#### **VTAC Privacy Consent**

Due to the Privacy Act, VTAC has revised its policy on the release of Year 12 information.

Consequently Upwey High School needs to seek your consent in order to determine school dux, subject duxes and student tracking. We also seek your permission to release your offer details to staff.

#### Uniform

By signing the Later Years Enrolment form students agree to abide by all school rules and understand that a condition of enrolment at Upwey High School is the wearing of full school uniform as endorsed by School Council.

#### **Summer Uniform (Boys and Girls)**

Mid-thigh in length, navy school shorts (**no sports shorts**) or navy school pants with plain black socks. Or School summer dress (just above the knee in length) with plain black UHS logo socks that are at least ankle level or above.

Years 10-12 – White/navy polo (Senior School logo) and navy V-necked jumper (school logo)

#### Winter Uniform (Boys and Girls)

Navy school shorts (mid-thigh in length) with plain black socks or navy school navy pants or School winter skirt - (just above the knee in length) and plain black socks or tights.

Years 10-12 - White/navy polo shirt (Senior School logo) and navy V-necked jumper (school logo)

#### **Shoes, Hats and Jackets**

The only acceptable footwear is plain, black, sturdy, polished, enclosed lace-up leather shoes with thick shoe sole. No canvas or suede shoes. No runners. No boots.

For health and safety reasons, students are never permitted to wear thongs, sandals, open-toed or backless shoes to school.

Any other accessories (scarves, hair ribbons/clips etc) should be navy or royal blue.

Jackets – navy blue lined jacket (school logo).

#### **Other Uniform Guidelines**

- All students in Years 7-12 are required to be in full school uniform at school and while travelling to and from school. The uniform is to be worn properly. Shirts are to be tucked in. No jumpers are to be worn tied around the waist
- All pants are to be hemmed at shoe level, not dragging on the ground with frayed hems.
  No denim, cords, or cargo pants
- Students with pierced ears are permitted to wear plain gold or silver sleepers or studs. Visible body-piercing jewellery must be plain sleepers or studs. Excessive amounts of makeup or nail polish, rings, necklaces and bracelets must not be worn to school.

#### **Driving a Vehicle**

Students wishing to drive to school during 2022 are required to apply to the Later Years Team Leader for permission. Please note – there is no student parking available on site.
