These films are based on true stories about a civil war/genocide in Rwanda, Africa and the Holocaust. The films do have an M rating. **We require parental permission for students to view the films.**

Understanding the M rating



Mature (M)

The content is moderate in impact

Films and computer games classified M (Mature) contain content of a moderate impact. Mrated films and computer games are not recommended for children under the age of 15. They include portrayals of elements such as violence and themes that require a mature outlook.

However, children under the age of 15 may legally access this material as the classification rating is an advisory category.

Parents, teachers and guardians may need to find out more about the specific content before deciding whether the material is suitable for children in their care.

We consider the content of all films before we select them for study and believe the value of these films is significant enough to depart from our normal policy of selecting PG rated films only. There are some scenes that depict the brutality of the civil war/genocide but these are completely in context, nongratuitous and integral to the overall storyline/theme of the film.

We believe these films to be valuable texts for stand-alone study and for comparative purposes and that they will provide students with a rewarding and extremely valuable learning experience.
