Course Counselling Process



Stages for Year 10 students selecting a course of study for Year 11 in 2023:

1. Subject investigations

In core subjects classes in the week beginning 1 August, students will spend time looking through the 2023 Later Years Subject Handbook with peers and staff to understand and ask questions about course and subject options

Students will use a subject selection proforma to draft selections in preparation for their course counselling appointment on Thursday 11 August at on Microsoft Teams.

2. Subject Information Night

A Subject Information night will be held on **Thursday 4 August on MS Teams**

Formal Presentation at **7:45pm-8.30pm** in the Later Years Centre

- Covers: VCE/Vocational Major//VET definitions, requirements and general Later Years information.

Individual access to teachers for questions from **5.00pm to 8.00pm** in the Science, Art & Tech Building—Staff from the school, plus TAFEs and Universities will be available to discuss subjects and courses on offer for Later Years students and their families on the night.

3. Course Counselling

Course Counselling will be provided to all students. The goal for each counselling session is to support the student to select their course of study and subjects for 2023.

- Counselling on Thursday 11 August from 1:00pm – 8:00pm with students and their families over MS Teams (**Daymap Booking information and MS Teams links to be advised**)
- Students are choosing preferences and will have the opportunity to talk through the careers pathways and interest. Counsellors will work together with families to assist in an appropriate selection of subjects

These preferences will assist in determining subjects that the School can offer and are not guaranteed.

4. Course Confirmation for 2023 Years 10-12 Students

Students and families will be given a preview of their potential course before Course Confirmation, so that there is an opportunity to make changes before locking this in, by appointment with the Later Years Assistant Principal. Course Confirmation is a three-step re-enrolment process that requires students and families to:

1. update all enrolment details and all year level package items
2. submit all forms to General Office and make payment where applicable
3. finalise confirmation of course.

Course Confirmation is from 4.00pm to 8.00pm on **Wednesday 5 October or Monday 10 October.**
