We have provided a brief explanation of all the charges to help you understand the costs we incur in providing your child's education.

<b>SCHOOL PLANNER</b> Every student is issued with a school planner, which is used as a means of communication between school and parents and to record homework	\$15.00
<b>MASTER SYSTEM LOCK</b> Year 7 students are expected to buy a combination lock available at the school. Cheaper locks are not suitable and may create problems with locker security	\$17.00
<b>LOCKER MAINTENANCE</b> This charge covers locker hire, repair and replacement	\$15.00
<b>HUMANITIES ASIA WISE COMPETITION</b> All Yr 7 students will participate in this competition	\$10.00
<b>DIDGERIDOO</b> In the Music Program all students will learn the culture, history, woodwork, science and art of this indigenous instrument, plus how to play it. The cost includes the purchase of a Didgeridoo	\$30.00
<b>SPORT LEVY</b> Cost of buses, ribbons, prizes and hire of venues for the whole school sporting events - Athletics Carnival, Swimming Carnival, Cross Country	\$20.00
<b>SWIMMING PROGRAM</b> Cost of buses, prizes and hire of venues for Year 7 & 8 Swimming Program	\$40.00
