



Course Selection Process & Course Confirmation (students in Year 10-12 in 2027)

1. Later Years Subject Information Night

A Subject Information night will be held on Wednesday 12th August from 5:00pm – 8:00pm in the Science, Art & Tech Building (D Block)

- Students and families will be able to ask questions and find out valuable information regarding subject offerings at Upwey High in 2027
- We will have staff presenting and answering questions about School Based Apprenticeships & Traineeships offered as a part of the VCE Vocational Major

2. Course Counselling

Course Counselling will be provided to all students. The goal for each counselling session is to support the student to select their course of study and subjects for 2027.

Course Counselling for Year 11 into 12 Students

- Subject selections made on Monday 27th July from 9:00am to 3.00pm, in class time via a one-on-one appointment with our Later Years course counsellors.

Course Counselling for Year 10 into 11 Students

- Monday 17th August in person from 1.00pm to 8.00pm by appointment – **No classes on the day for Year 10 students**
- **Family members required** – bookings via Compass

Course Counselling for Year 9 into 10 Students

- Counselling on Friday 14th August from 8.50am to 3.10pm in person with counsellors from the Later Years Team
- Students are choosing preferences and must meet compulsory subject selections when putting in choices, which will be discussed in Aspire classes leading up to the Subject Information Night and Course Counselling.

These preferences will assist in determining subjects that the School can offer and are not guaranteed.

3. Course Confirmation for 2027 Years 10-12 Students

Students and families will be given a preview of their potential course (in Term 3) before Course Confirmation, so that there is an opportunity to make changes before locking this in, by appointment with the Later Years Assistant Principal. Course Confirmation is a three-step re-enrolment process that requires students and families to:

1. update all enrolment details and all year level package items (packages will be via Compass)
2. submit all forms through Compass
3. make payment where applicable and finalise confirmation of courses.
